<p>Board of Code Review</p>	<p>FIREFIGHTER/EMT VACANCY: Membership in the BCR shall be limited to seven (7) in number. Members appointed to the BCR shall serve at the will and pleasure of the Board of County Commissioners and shall serve until their successors are appointed. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment by the Board for the unexpired term. Members appointed to the BCR shall be residents of Johnson County, Kansas, and shall not be individuals who currently hold elected office within the boundaries of the County; nor shall they be appointed or hired employees of the County or its agencies, departments or commissions; nor shall they be appointees by the Board of County Commissioners to any other position, board or commission that performs services for and on behalf of the Board.</p>	<p>Chairman</p>
<p>Planning Commission</p>	<p>TWO INCORPORATED AND ONE UNINCORPORATED POSITION: The commission shall consist of not less than nine nor more than 12 members who shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. Nine of such members shall be residents of the unincorporated area of the county. The planning commission shall consist of one member of each zoning board in the county, as appointed by the Board of County Commissioners.</p>	<p>Chairman</p>
